




- Today's statewide case count is 666, with 403 cases (60%) in Maricopa County, similar to population distribution. This represents a typical drop in cases reported on Monday due to weekend effect. The 7-day average for reported cases is now 1311.
- The epi curve continues to increase in Maricopa County and statewide. The pattern observed now remains concerning for early phases of potential exponential growth.
- Percent positivity is 9.7% both statewide and in Maricopa County with a significant drop in testing numbers reported today. Significantly more testing is needed to characterize the extent of the current outbreak.
- Hospital utilization and ED visits continue to increase, with inpatient bed usage for COVID-19 at levels similar to late May (just prior to the onset of exponential growth). There is no indication that hospital resources are at imminent risk of becoming overwhelmed.


















Arizona Statewide Analysis

























Hospital Usage
