PLAN FOR STUDENTS**



Our mission is to provide quality health care at an affordable rate to the students at ASU. ASU Health Services (Polytechnic, Tempe, West) are able to offer low-cost lab, basic x-ray (Tempe only) or consultation with an on-campus specialist. Even though you may have medical insurance, some of today's plans will not cover students because they are not receiving medical care at a facility close to their home. Many of these plans have high deductible for "out-of-network" care or they will not pay for anything that is not an emergency.

This is not an insurance policy. It is a way to reduce your total healthcare costs for certain services rendered at one of the following campus locations: Tempe, Polytechnic or West, and covers students regardless of the number of visits they make. All tests/exams must be ordered by staff clinicians at the above listed locations.

Cost for Bridge Plan Discount Program

Enrollment in the Bridge Service Plan Discount Program is open year round. Automatic re-enrollment will occur for future semesters once enrolled. Withdrawal from the Bridge Service Plan may be requested by notifying Health Services Billing Office in writing up to two weeks from the start of the coverage period. The cost of enrollment is \$129 per semester (Aug. 16 - Jan. 3 and Jan. 4 - Aug. 15), and may be purchased at any time during the semester.

Note: mid-semester enrollment is not retroactive.

Additional Benefits

Counseling

ASU Counseling Services on the Tempe, Polytechnic, and West campuses offers counseling visits to all registered ASU students. Services covered by the Bridge Plan include time-limited individual, couples and group counseling as well as case management services. Hours of operation are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. ASU Counseling Services on the Tempe Campus is located in the Student Services Building, room 334 and can be reached at 480.965.6146. ASU Counseling Services on the Polytechnic Campus is located in Sutton Hall, suite 240 and can be reached at 480.727.1255. ASU Counseling Services on the West Campus is located in the University Center Building, room 221 and can be reached at 602.543.8125.

After-Hours Medical Advice

Enrollment in the Bridge Plan gives students access to after-hours telephone advice from a physician or nurse practitioner. A medical provider is on call 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Physical Therapy

Physiotherapy Associates offers a discounted physical therapy visit for \$30 (instead of \$60) for students who are on the Bridge Service Plan. They are located in the Student Recreation Center (SRC), Room 124A. To schedule an appointment call 480.829.0217.

Audiological Evaluation (hearing test)

The ASU Speech and Hearing Clinic offer Bridge Plan Students a hearing assessment for \$30. The ASU Speech and Hearing Clinic generally maintains operating hours of 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. MST, Monday through Friday. The clinic observes all university holidays. *Location and contact information on back panel.*
