ACD 804: Tobacco-Free Campus

Purpose

To protect the health and safety of university faculty, staff, students, and visitors on the campuses of ASU

Sources

Arizona Revised Statutes §§ 36–601.01 as amended

Applicability

University faculty, staff, students and visitors

Background

ASU recognizes that tobacco use is a public health hazard and is dedicated to providing a healthy, comfortable and educationally productive learning environment for faculty, staff, students and visitors.

The university complies with state law on smoking.

Policy

[Smoking](#) and the use of smokeless tobacco products are prohibited in or on all university:

1. owned property
2. leased property
3. facilities
4. grounds
5. parking structures (including in privately owned vehicles)
6. university-owned vehicles

Exceptions:

1. Privately owned vehicles (on public roads)
2. Leased university residences that have been designated as smoking
