## **ACD 804:** Tobacco-Free Campus

#### Purpose

To protect the health and safety of university faculty, staff, students, and visitors on the campuses of ASU

#### Sources

Arizona Revised Statutes §§ 36-601.01 as amended

### Applicability

University faculty, staff, students and visitors

#### Background

ASU recognizes that tobacco use is a public health hazard and is dedicated to providing a healthy, comfortable and educationally productive learning environment for faculty, staff, students and visitors.

The university complies with state law on smoking.

### Policy

Smoking and the use of smokeless tobacco products are prohibited in or on all university:

- 1. owned property
- 2. leased property
- 3. facilities
- 4. grounds
- 5. parking structures (including in privately owned vehicles)
- 6. university-owned vehicles

Exceptions:

- 1. Privately owned vehicles (on public roads)
- 2. Leased university residences that have been designated as smoking
