INFORMATION AND CONSENT FORM
FOR WOMEN RECEIVING MEASLES, MUMPS, & RUBELLA VACCINE

Do you understand that Rubella ("German Measles") is a disease which can cause serious birth defects in an unborn child if the mother catches the disease while she is pregnant?

Do you understand that the Measles, Mumps, and Rubella Vaccine can cause serious birth defects in an unborn child of a pregnant woman if the vaccine is given during the first month of pregnancy?

If you think you are pregnant, you should not get the vaccine at this time. Ask your nurse for more information.

If you are not pregnant now and you decide to be vaccinated, it is important that you do not get pregnant for at least one month.
