## **ASU Family Trivia instructions**

### **Supplies**

- Jeopardy-style playing board:
  - Print out or view the board with categories and points available
  - Cards can also be written onto their own sheets and taped up onto a clear wall space, where they can be flipped to reveal the prompts once categories are selected and the game proceeds.
  - Answers will be read from the key by the "host."
- Pens/pencils/markers and paper/whiteboard for score keeping
- Pens/pencils/markers and paper/whiteboards for contestants to write their answers
- Bells/buzzer system to signify turns for contestants
- Answer key
- Rules & Guidelines (see below)
- Prize for winner(s)

#### **Rules & Guidelines**

- Players can participate individually or on teams. Each player/team should have a method to write down answers when categories and questions are selected.
- Players are able to select the category and point value that will determine the question to be answered.
- Once a question is read aloud, participants have 5 seconds to respond and indicate their ready answer.
- The participant can earn points based on the fastest, correct answer.
- The winning participant for that round will select the next category and point value.
- Incorrect answers: Points will be deducted instead of added, and other participants will have the chance to answer the question for the same amount of points.
- The participant(s) with the most points wins!
