

ASU Family Action Items

From now through August, complete your family to-do list to become "Family Ready" and to prepare for your student's transition to ASU.

Join the ASU Family Hub to receive official ASU Family communications to learn about resources for you and your Sun Devil, receive invites for family programs, and much more.
Encourage your student to complete priority tasks listed on their My ASU and check their email regularly. Upper-division families say this is a key skill for students to learn and helps ensure they don't miss important university updates.
Don't forget the housing priority deadline is May 15. All students who complete their application by this date are guaranteed on-campus housing in the fall. Students who complete their application by May 1 can self select their room and roommate.
Attend a virtual Parent and Family Orientation session to explore next steps and key resources. Family participation in orientation has been shown to boost retention and sense of belonging among first-year students.
Check out our ASU Family Connection Live series over the summer. Just for the families of incoming students, virtual sessions are hosted live by university staff to explore topics such as move-in, career services, academic support services and more.
Get to know your ASU Family community! Join our Welcome to the Family Chat series to connect virtually with other incoming families and ask upper-division parents any questions.
Have financial aid questions? Discuss them with your student's Admissions Team Member.
Plan for your student's healthcare coverage. If they will be covered under your family's health insurance plan, check to ensure that it's accepted at ASU Health Services . ASU also offers student health insurance and bridge discount plans.
Talk to your student about My ASU Guest Access. Through this important tool, students can choose to share FERPA-protected information such as grades or finances with you.
Help your student practice "adulting": do laundry, make a medical appointment, initiate conversations, manage key tasks (the New Student Orientation process is great for this!)
Discuss a communication plan with your student. Explore this topic and others in the first-year videos from our ASU Family Connection Video series.
